Resort Breaks Ground on New Employee Housing

ACME, Mich., July 27, 2022 – Ground has been broken and construction has started on a new building for employee housing at Grand Traverse Resort and Spa. "We all come to America to work hard for our families. A roof over our head is important," says Seekoei. "Major kudos to the Grand Traverse Resort and Spa for working to give us the best accommodations possible. It is within walking distance to the property and will be the best housing experience for those from foreign countries."

Construction is being done by the Resort's ownership, Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians, and the Grand Traverse Economic Development. Construction is expected to be completed in March 2023.
